Maths – Year 3: your focus today will be to practise grid method. I have included detailed learning reminders, but I am sure you will use your prior knowledge to work through it. Have a go at the challenge too!

Year 4: today you will be using your multiplication knowledge to multiply three numbers using commutativity. I've explained in detail – please look at my explanation and examples 😊

Edit & improve checklist

Have you used:

Capital letters at the beginning of sentences and for proper nouns?	
Correct punctuation? (.,?!)	
Have you read over your work to check it makes sense?	
Checked your spelling is correct? Write it x3 at the bottom	
Paragraphs to divide your story into parts?	
Interesting vocabulary? Check and change at least 3 words	
Expanded noun phrases?	
Conjunctions?	
Clear description?
