Year 1 LO – to begin to use jottings to add

Use jottings to draw the first number and then carefully add the ones from the second number. Remember jottings represent the dienes so a stick of 10 dienes is drawn as a line and a dienes cube for one is a dot. Watch the video and I will explain more.

$34 + 4 =$	$17 + 2 =$	$46 + 2 =$	$21 + 5 =$
$12 + 6 =$	$25 + 3 =$	$15 + 4 =$	$33 + 6 =$

Year 2 To subtract (bridging 10.)

Choose a number from the circle and subtract a number from the triangle. Write the number sentence and solve it using jottings. Remember to subtract the tens and then the ones. You may be bridging 10 so will need to swap a ten for 10 ones.
