Creativity

To promote creativity in all subjects and to help strengthen the links in learning, the **context** for learning in art and design, design technology and music are often within topics in subjects such as science, history or geography. In addition, we want children to develop skills of evaluation across all subjects.

Art and Design

Specifically within art, children are asked to be reflective and develop their initial ideas. They will return to key materials so that they develop proficiency in techniques. To help model possibilities, they will review the work of key artists, architects and designers. Children will learn how art and design contribute to different cultures.

Design Technology

We aim to extend children's creativity in designing and making objects to solve problems within different contexts. Children are asked to apply knowledge and understanding of science, maths, computing, and art in design and technology projects. They will be asked to be resourceful and consider financial costs and profit. Within geography and science they will, when appropriate, consider the environmental or cultural impact of technology.

Music

We aim that music engages and inspires pupils to develop both their love of music and their talents as musicians. We will develop children's confidence, sense of achievement and creativity. As pupils progress they will develop an ability to critique, compose and appreciate a range of styles.
