2017 New 12-Sided £1 Coin

Outer ring - Nickel-brass
Inner ring - Nickel-plated
nickel-brass



Design flows over Inner
and Outer ring making it
more difficult for
counterfeiters to replicate

Micro-letting on the inside rim on both
sides of the coin. The words 'ONE POUND'
on the obverse and the year of production
on the reverse e.g. '2017'
