This week we welcomed Rev. David in to school to lead our assembly, where he focused on values and linked them to two different Bible stories. In assembly on Tuesday, the children were learning about Leap Years - as 2024 is a leap year! The children were discussing what a leap year is, what it means in different parts of the world and if they knew anyone who was born on 29th February.

Earlier in the week, I had the pleasure of teaching in Classes 2 and 4. In Class 2 we were planning and designing our own dinosaurs, then giving them the most inventive names! Mine was Mrs Muirasaurus! In Class 4 the children were teaching me all about the Humanist Faith - they have learnt so much already this term.

I visited Class 1 on Thursday and was incredibly impressed with the phonics the children had been learning - their reading is developing really well and they all seemed to be having such a lovely time. Then yesterday I was invited to view Class 3's Mummified tomatoes! They had scooped out the insides of a tomato, created a mix out of salt and bicarbonate of soda which they put inside the tomato, in the same way the Ancient Egyptians used natron. They are hoping this will remove the moisture in approximately 40 days and then they are going to be wrapping their tomatoes and placing them in a sarcophagus. I will have further updates for you after half term!
