Our Music teacher, Mrs Roberts, would like to let parents know that there is the provision for your child to learn a musical instrument at Foxton Primary School. Mrs Roberts has availability from this term for your child to learn woodwind or piano: Flute (year 3 upwards) Clarinet (year 3 upwards) Alto saxophone (year 5 upwards) or Piano (year 2 upwards). The age ranges listed above are only guidelines and therefore Mrs Roberts is in school on Tuesday mornings to meet any prospective pupils. All of the above instruments can be hired from Wood, Wind and Reed or Music Gallery in Cambridge. Individual 20 minute lessons are £11.50. Lessons are invoiced at the start of each term. There are a limited number of spaces available and lessons will be agreed on a first come first served basis.
