

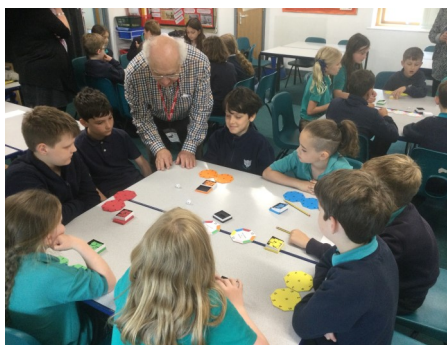
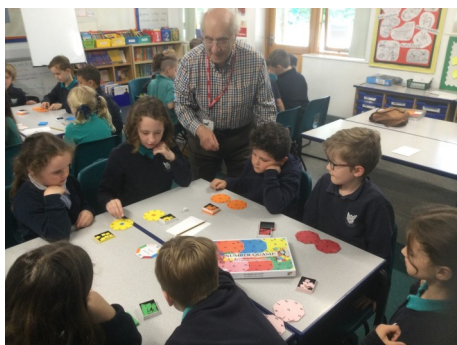
# Foxton Primary Newsletter
